"He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain what he cannot lose." We all lose something somewhere sometime in order to gain more for Jesus. It was 22 years ago when God called me from a small village; I quickly obeyed, came to Tema to be trained in the Greater Grace Bible college for four years and graduated in 1993 with the first graduating class under Pastor Scibelli. I served under Pastor John Jason in Ashaiman and then with Pastor Morley, who started the church in Accra, our capital city. Later, I joined Pastor Coffee in Bolgatanga in the north and taught there in the Bible college. Then, I moved back to join Pastor Lawson Doe to start Grace Community Church in Ashaiman New Town in the Capital District. Now, I serve as the Pastor of Greater Grace Church in Accra East.

I have seen many men and women trained in our Accra Bible Institute. Then, in November 2009, we were asked to vacate the facility because the government had plans to use it for its purposes. The following three months we worshiped in a sister's hall. We faced opposition like Nehemiah or like any other godly and faithful servant would in the work of God. Later, we were offered a plot of land to buy in a hire/purchase agreement, which we are still paying off. We moved to that bare open field with no building, no shade, and no shed even to store church chairs or any other thing. We met under a canopy for one year in every kind of weather – in the rain, in strong winds. The church grew stronger in the faith.

The congregation loves the Word, the Body fellowship, and going after the lost. God is honoring our assembly with much favor as He's adding souls to the church. I have been teaching grace life for a season now and it is bringing life revival to many. Recently we had a Couples' Day with the newly wedded and it was so heart touching.

The "Taking the Word to the World" West Africa conference last January with Pastor Scibelli, along with pastors from Zambia, Togo, Benin, Burkina Faso, USA,

Pastor Traoré and I went to Bamako, the capital city of Mali. We used every opportunity to open the Bible and share the Word of God. We met a pastor named Dara who stayed with us every evening till midnight. We also met a pastor responsible for a ministry that has 34 churches. We gave him some booklets by Pastor Stevens and audio messages from our radio program in Burkina Faso.

We are praying that in September a team with Pastor Traoré Daouda could go to Mali to begin a church in Bamako. We left Bamako for Dakar, Senegal, and prayed on the bus with two people to receive Christ. In Dakar, we fellowshiped with Pastor Ibou Faye late into the night. A young person I knew came to see us with his friend. Both of them were very open. We gave message DVDs and CDs to different pastors. From Dakar, we took a three-hour journey to Kaolak, a big city in Senegal. Pray for Bationo Laurent, a young couturier who was touched by our visit to Senegal.

Glory to God for His work in our country, Burkina Faso. In each of our nine churches, the message of the grace of God is preached. Great men of God serve the Lord faithfully with humility: Pastor Rufin Ouedraogo serves in Zongo, Pastor Félix Bamouni in Koudougou, Pastor Michée Sama in Réo, Pastor Rémi Bationo in Ténado, Pastor Fidèle Bado in Balélédo, Pastor Maurice Bado in Kilsho, Pastor Bazié Barthelemy in Bonyolo, and I serve the church in Ouagadougou. Every weekend Pastor Koffi Tsiplonou and other pastors go to Bobo-Dioulasso to minister. We see the work go on by the grace of God. We are getting ready to touch Ziniaré, located 35 km from Ouaga.

The way of God leads to life. Our Lord is not a hard master; He is a loving Shepherd leading us gently. David said in Psalm 18:35b: "Thy hand has held me up, and thy gentleness has made me great." We exhorted the church on the importance of studying at the Bible college. We bless the Lord for the 130 registered students. We teach and also show classes from the ITS Paris and MBC&S in

We have reinforcement from Burkina Faso as Pasteur Michée came to join us in the mission. If one can drive out 1,000, then two can drive out 10,000. Prayers are answered by God; He who has called us is faithful, and it is He who will also do it.

By the grace of God our church has been growing. We have church services on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings. We spend very good moments in the presence of the Lord. New people are added to us more and more. We see the work of the Spirit of God grow in Niger.

"Through wisdom is a house built; and by understanding it is established: and by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches" Proverbs 24:3-4. The house of wisdom teaches us to decrease so it can become larger. Our Bible college is the framework for the spiritual building. Students are studying hard. We plan to have our first student banquet.

We enjoy getting the Baltimore messages on mp3 discs. Thank you so much for your love and support.

Your prayers will yield even to a greater increase of God in Niger. We are looking to purchase land to build our own church facility and an orphanage. We're pressured to move as people refuse to rent places to Christians.

Thank you for the support of our children's home for orphans. God always surprises us by His faithfulness. We need financing to build and furnish classrooms at our Christian school. We trust God for His provisions.

We support our churches in the provinces by visits, initiating outreach times, and morning devotionals. We've already seen churches grow. Extension Bible school classes allow students in the provinces to use our program of education.

Last spring, we evangelized in seven villages and preached the Gospel to about 11,000 people. Some 450 people gave their lives to Christ.

Our Easter Conference took place at Ténado, 125 km from Ouaga. Members from our eight churches with all their pastors were present for this time of communion around the Word. We preached every evening in the open and hundreds of people gave their lives to Christ.
