





GGWO—20 Years in Ukraine

It was 20 years ago that Pastor Schaller, Pastor Matti, a group of us from Poland, Hungary, and the former Soviet Union converged on Ukraine for a Winter Conference in January 2001 in L'viv.

This past November we had an anointed and powerful time at our conference with Pastor Matti Sirvio. At this 20-year mark, we rejoice to see six churches and assemblies continue in the grace of God with Ukrainian leadership. Much thanks goes out to GGWO in Baltimore and MBC&S for the training, resources, and support for our ministry in Ukraine.

In L'viv, with Pastor Myhaylo, our Bible school has grown this semester as well as our Christian school – the first of its kind in western Ukraine. We are seeing the next generation of young men being raised up. Please keep Oleksay, Vitalik, Alik, and Taras in your prayers. These young men would like to study at MBC&S.

The ministry with Pastor Sasha in Odessa has grown with new believers and new students in the Bible school. The church is excited at the imminent arrival of Peter Merry! Please be in prayer as it is on our hearts to see a day program begin for orphans. It is said that at least 10,000 homeless children live on the streets of Odessa. Oktay and Nishana, missionaries from Baku, arrived this past summer to Odessa and have been a great blessing to the team. Keep them and their daughter in prayer and for God's provision for their labor.

Bill and Ira Toppi got married in September and have been a support to Pastor Max and the church in Cherkassy. Our prayer for the saints in Cherkassy is for the continued blessing in their Bible school and the protection over Sasha, Sergey, and other young men that God has put his hand on.

Pastor Roman and Albina, who got married in September, moved to Kyiv with a team to minister to the precious assembly in the capital. Pastor Gromov, who is moving to Crimea with his wife to minister to the Tatar, a Muslim people group, visits Kyiv two weeks out of every month. Please keep Kostia, Andrirej, Sasha, and Mani in your prayers; they are young men who have a vision to serve God.

Ukraine is open more than ever for missions. Ukraine is considered by many international missions organizations as one of the most open countries in Europe. The government is still receptive of missionaries. Our prayer pleas to the Lord of the harvest are for youth leaders, Bible school students, and the next generation of leaders.

Looking to the horizon of God's heart for Ukraine and beyond we can see a church in eastern Ukraine, possibly in Dnipropetrovsk. We hold contacts in three other cities in Ukraine where there is no pastor as of yet.

When we talk about foreign missions, it would be easy to focus on the material need that is so obvious, but the greatest need we have in Ukraine is for pastors, men that are described as "ministers of a flame of fire" in Hebrews 1:14. We have a prayer burden for 27 Ukrainian pastors in each one of the 27 provinces in Ukraine and beyond to bordering countries.

Let's believe God that in the next five years we see Ukrainian men be raised up, come to Baltimore and move by faith to the field and minister. Ukraine is not far; it is the same distance for them and for us to the throne of grace. We are part of one another, born from the same seed, the incorruptible seed of 1 Peter 1:23.
